

History

A spin-off of the Citizens' Police Academy was created in 2001 for youths between the ages of 8 and 13 years old. Many of the adult participants requested some type of session for their children; therefore, the Youth Citizen's Police Academy was conceived. Due to the first session's popularity, the year 2002 saw an extended attendance day. The first academy was only four hours a day for one week; however, Session 2 saw the hours extended to an eight-hour day for one week.

In the summer of 2009, we initiated Special Forces Summer Camp for children with special needs. Using the principals and theories of the Youth Citizen's Police Academy, this camp was designed with the special needs associated with specially challenged children. There has been such enthusiasm, support, and volunteerism with this camp that we now have extended it from 3 days to a full week long camp.

Information

The Youth Citizens' Police Academy attempts to expand the youths' knowledge of the Law Enforcement profession, as well as introduce them to the prospect of obtaining a Law Enforcement Career. However, along with this option comes the introduction of being a concerned and active community member. The youth's exposure ranges from drug and alcohol education and school violence, crime scene investigation, bicyclesafety, firearmssafety, outdoor activities, etc. At the conclusion of each session, a graduation ceremony is held for the participants, much like that of the adult Citizens' Police Academy.

The Sports Camp is designed to help the children learn life skills involving team work, getting along with each other, as well as the technical skill for whichever sport is highlighted in that particular sports camp.

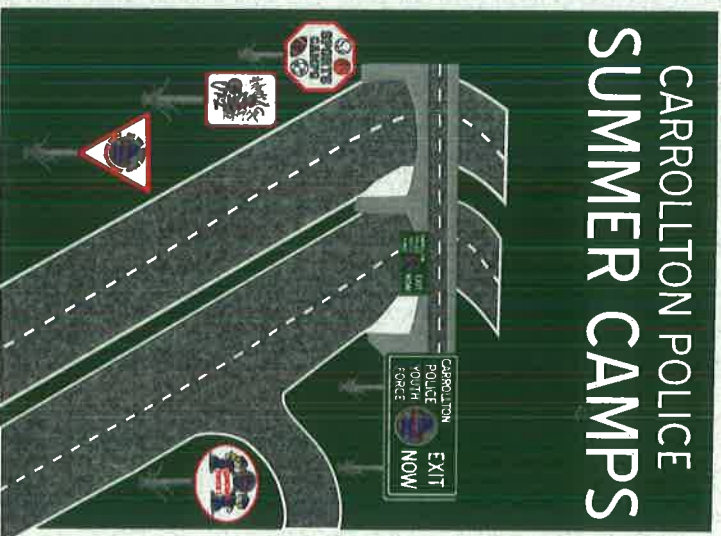
